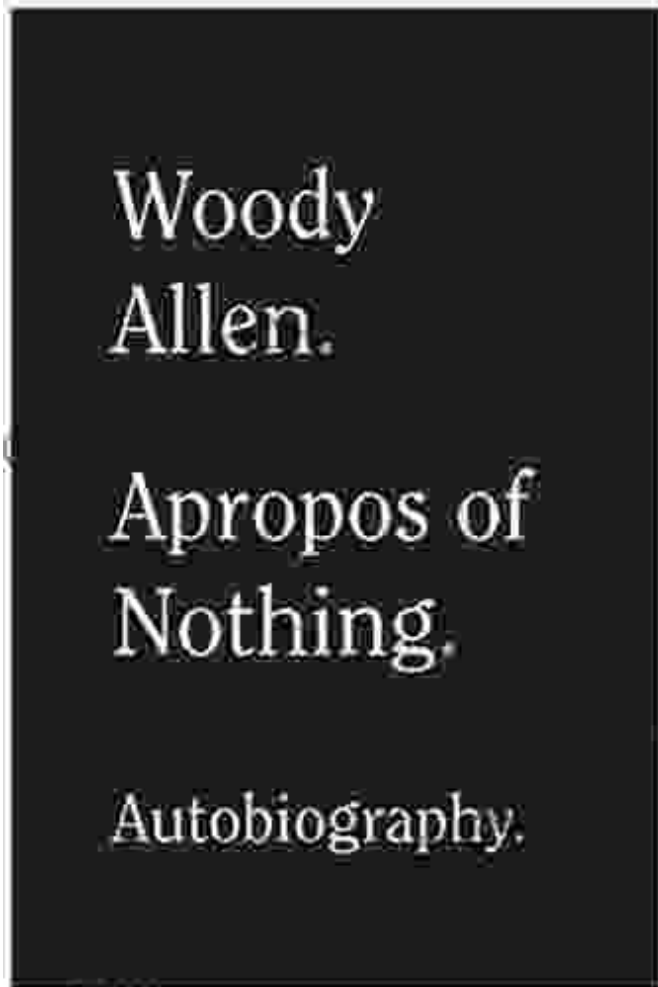


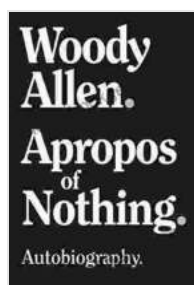
Apropos of Nothing: Woody Allen's Controversial Memoir

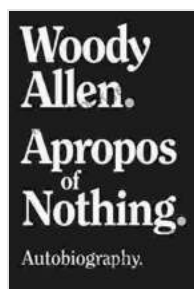
