## **Mount Zion**

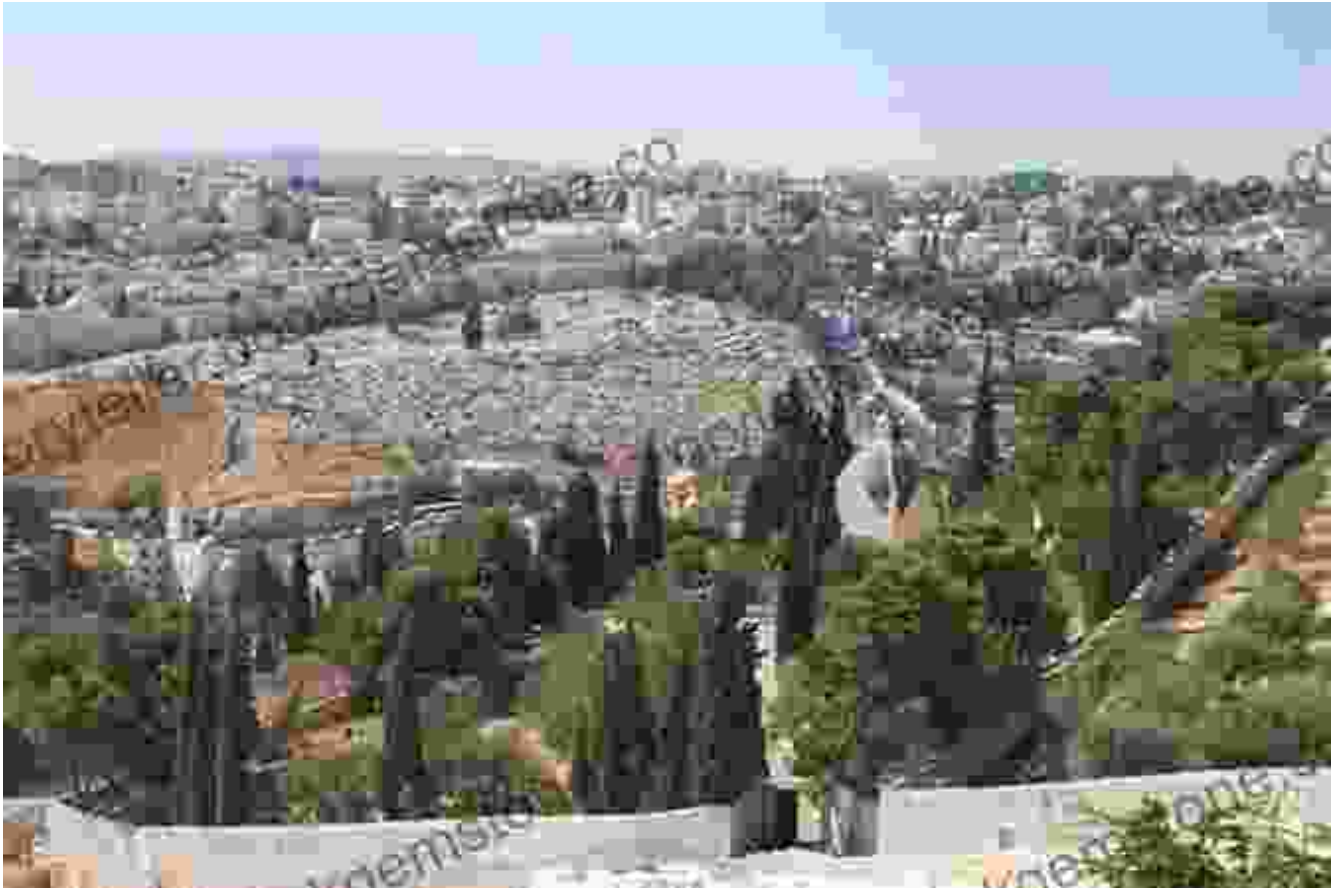
