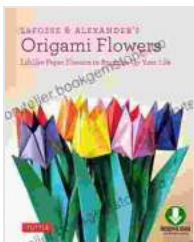

Materials

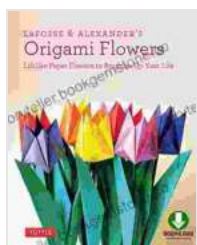
