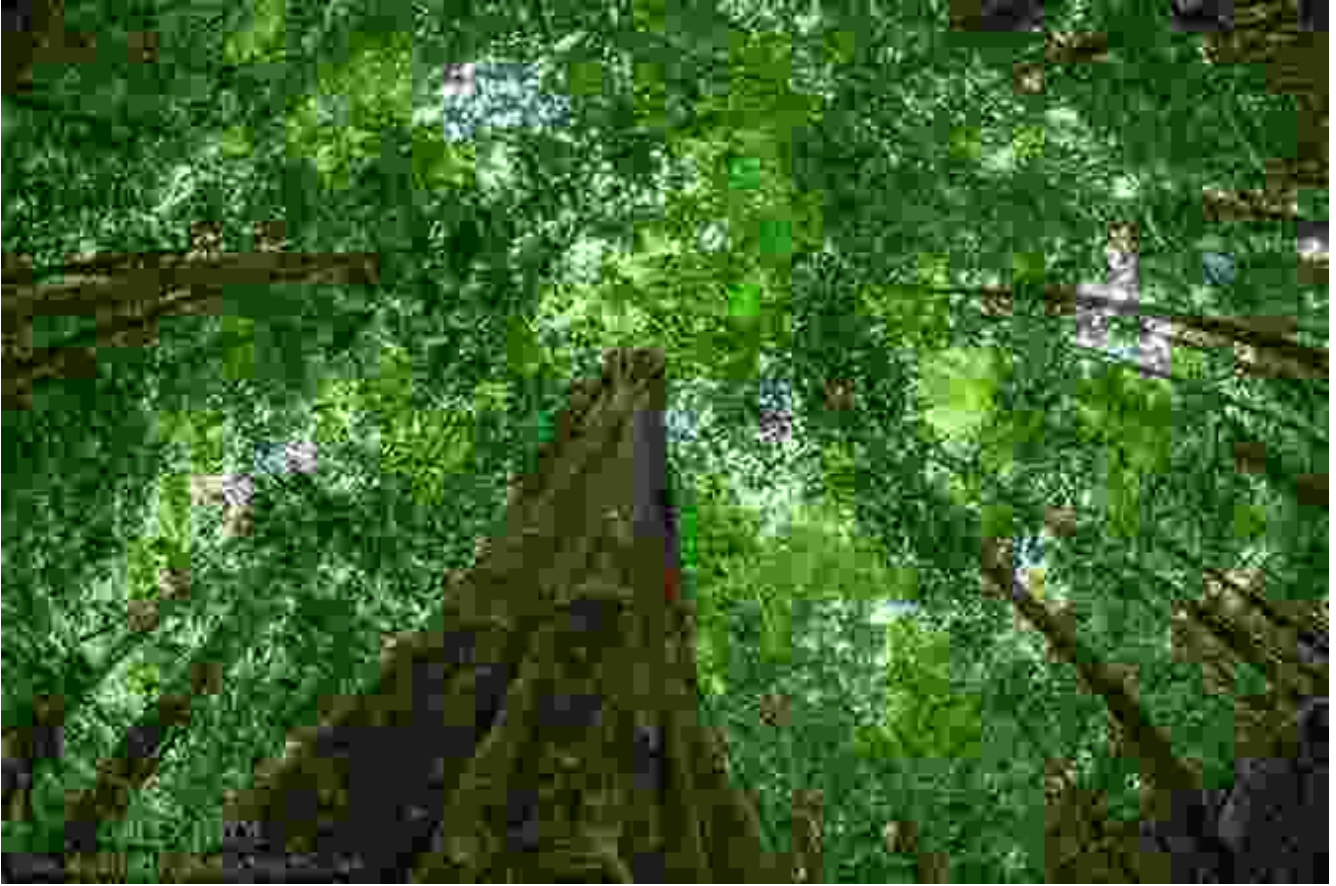
Nicaragua
