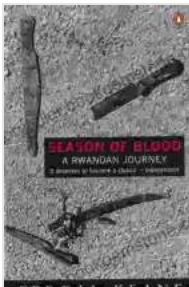


Season of Blood: A Rwandan Journey into Darkness and Redemption

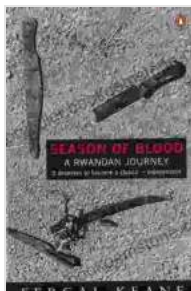
